MODULE SUMMARY

Students will be given the opportunity to improve upon their skills as a sport or society official and will be able to pass on these skills for the benefit of their team / group and the university. On completion of this module students will be able to reflect on and discuss the competencies gained as a sports or societies official and identify any areas they may wish to develop in the future.
