MODULE SUMMARY

CUSU understand the challenges many learners face managing their study alongside external commitments. The aim of this module is to provide a flexible study environment that enables the learner to develop awareness and reflect on their personal performance and employability in the workplace using self-analysis, feedback from others and through continuing professional development planning within existing paid or unpaid employment they currently hold or have completed within the academic year. The module will encourage the learner to utilise their employment to identify areas for improvement and enable them to develop a range of transferable graduate skills to enhance their own personal branding documents such as their Curriculum Vitae and optimise/facilitate their transition into the graduate labour market; highlight the importance of and equipping them with the skills and understanding to enable lifelong learning.
